

DRSSC Membership Policy

What Defines a DRSSC Member?

A member of the DRYTC Corporation, operating as DRSSC, must meet the following DRSSC By-Laws:

- 1. Have completed registration, signed off on the included policies & paid the annual sports membership.
- 2. Annual membership fees are determined by the board each year prior to season opening.
- 3. DRSSC memberships are non-transferable.
- 4. DRSSC memberships start at the date of membership payment and expire April 1.

DRSSC Classes of Memberships, Definitions and Voting Rights

There are four classes of DRSSC memberships:

1. Sport Member

Is a voting member.

A sport Member has registered and paid their membership in full, for at least one sport, for the year.

2. Social Member

Is a non-voting member.

A Social Member has registered and paid their social membership in full.

3. Junior Courts Member

Is a non-voting member.

A Junior Courts Member must be 18 years old or under. Junior Members must be registered by a parent or custodian, who has also signed the waiver.

4. Honorary Member

An honorary Member can be appointed by the Board for specific reasons based on their specific skills and/or duties. The application to designate an Honorary Membership requires endorsement by two Board Members. The appointment is subject to a Board motion and vote in a BOD meeting. The Board will then decide if the Honorary Member is a voting member.

DRSSC Member Rights

All members share several rights, including the right to a free copy of:

- DRSSC non-profit's articles and bylaws, and amendments to them
- DRSSC AGM, BOD meetings, as well as minutes of member meetings /meetings of member committees
- DRSSC financial statements
- DRSSC member resolutions and resolutions from any committee of members
- A complete list of DRSSC Directors
- A complete list of DRSSC Officers
- A register of any ownership interests in land
- Club financial statements
- Request member lists, for a reasonable fee, including member names and contact information.

The member must agree in writing that the member list will only be used for the following reasons:

To influence how members vote

To demand a members' meeting

To conduct other matters related to the nonprofit's activities
